# Thank you

We gratefully thank participants, sponsors, and supporters of our 7th annual 2023 Dollars for Scholars event. The generosity exhibited by Bentley Village residents was truly heartening. Your extraordinary giving spirit surpasses the levels we've observed in communities across the globe.

Since its inception in 2016, the Bentley Village Foundation has awarded 99 "Bentley Wings" competitive scholarships with total awards over \$750,000. Some award recipients are the first in their families to attend college, and some were enabled to pursue advanced education that otherwise would not have been possible.

Dollars for Scholars, one of the annual Foundation fundraising events, featured a golf tournament, a raffle, an awards banquet, an online auction, and a silent auction for the golfers at the awards banquet.

Thanks to dedicated volunteers and Trustees who have worked tirelessly

over the years, the Foundation continues to thrive and provide scholarships to Vi at Bentley Village employees and their dependents giving them the boost needed to better their lives.

<u>Dollars for Scholars sets a New Record!</u> Thanks to our residents for their wonderful support of the Dollars for Scholars Fundraising Event, we raised almost \$150,000. Still limited to only 15 holes, creative planning and organization by the Committee and Golf Pro, Stan Geer, scored a real win again by having two golf scrambles played with both morning and afternoon golfers.

Thanks to the hole sponsor team, hole sponsorships increased by 20% this year. Our industrious auction team solicited great auction items raising almost \$13,000, up by 27%.

Over 2,000 raffle tickets were sold, and many residents decided to donate in lieu of buying raffle tickets.

Thank you for participating in the "Dollars for Scholars" event. Whether you engaged in golf, sponsored the event, supported a hole, participated in the raffle or silent auctions, your continued contributions to the scholarship fund have been crucial in shaping a brighter future for our scholars.

This year, the Foundation awarded a record 14 scholarships to deserving students. These scholarships open doors that many awardees never thought possible. Your support helps

to turn their dreams into reality. Many of our scholars come from families who have immigrated to the US for a better life. Some did not speak English when they reached our shores. Some came from among the poorest communities in the world.

Your support is instrumental in continuing the "Bentley Wings" Scholarship program. You have funded the \$84,000 needed for this year's new scholars plus the money to meet our obligations to previous scholarship awardees. Since the scholarships are renewable, we have 31 active scholars from scholarships awarded from 2017-2023 producing a future financial obligation of approximately \$650,000.

### 34 OF OUR "BENTLEY WINGS" SCHOLARS HAVE GRADUATED

Bently Village Foundation awarded its first scholarships in 2016 and has awarded a total of 99 scholarships. Scholarships are available to any member of the Vi at Bentley Village workforce and/or their dependents and may be used for any accredited institution offering advanced education and/or vocational training.

Elene Pierre, daughter of Ann Pierre, Culinary Services, thanks all those who made her "Bentley Wings" Competitive Scholarship possible. She says, "Your help with my education has put me on a path that will lead me to academic success. I began to get discouraged because I thought, that although I worked hard in school, I did not receive any scholarships. But you took a chance on me and granted me a scholarship. Your actions have reminded me to continue to have Hope and my efforts will be rewarded. You have given me the motivation that I need to excel in school in these upcoming years. I will forever be grateful for what you have done. I may not know you on a personal level but I wanted to say that I will make you proud. Thank you and God bless you."

Elene is the youngest of four children. Her parents moved to Immokalee from Haiti to create a better life for their family. As the youngest, she was born in the US. Her father passed away ten years ago, leaving her mother to raise her children as a single parent. Since her family is from Haiti, Elene is fluent in English and Creole and speaks some French.

Elene believes that her medical training will provide tools her the tools to better understand very young patients who cannot communicate their symptoms — critical skills for any neonatal nurse. Plus, she cites trust, patience, compassion, kindness, and honesty as essential to success in the medical field.

Elene is a freshman at Florida Gulf Coast University. Her goal is to be a neonatal nurse to be able to restore the health of ill babies. She also hopes to extend the limited medical care provided in her home town including the care of newborns.
