We gratefully thank all participants, sponsors, volunteers, and supporters of the 8th annual 2024 Dollars for Scholars event.

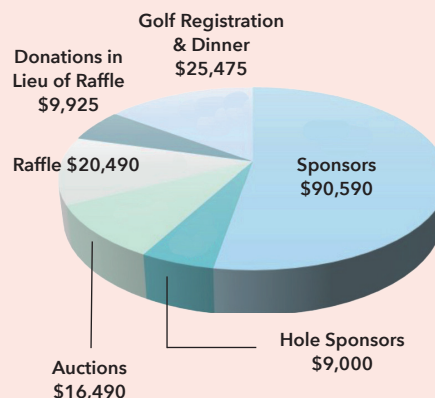

Dollars for Scholars Sets a New Record!

Thanks to our residents and sponsoring organizations for their wonderful support of the Dollars for Scholars Fundraising Event. We raised over \$170,000 – A new record! The tournament was played on the 18-hole course with three new holes and featured morning and afternoon golf scrambles, plus putting and chipping contests. Thanks to our generous residents, sponsorships increased by almost 43%. Over 2,000 raffle tickets were sold, and many residents decided to donate in lieu of buying raffle tickets.

Thank You from the “Bentley Wings” Competitive Scholarship Program

Thanks to everyone who participated in the Dollars for Scholars event. Whether you engaged in golf, sponsored the event, sponsored a hole, participated in the raffle or auctions, or donated to the scholarship fund, your continued contributions have been crucial in shaping a brighter future for our scholars.

This year, the Foundation awarded eight scholarships to deserving students. These scholarships open doors that many awardees never thought possible. Your support helps turn their dreams into reality. Many of our scholars come from families who have immigrated to the US for a better life. Some did not speak English when they reached our shores. Some came from among the poorest communities in the world.

Your support is instrumental in continuing our “Bentley Wings” Competitive Scholarship program. You have helped to fund this year’s eight new scholars plus the money to meet our obligations to 22 previous scholarship awardees who are still actively pursuing their education. This year’s obligation for the 30 active scholarships is \$180,000. Since the scholarships are renewable for eight years, our estimated total future obligation for these scholars is approximately \$888,000.

Bentley Village Foundation awarded its first “Bentley Wings” scholarships in 2016, the year the Foundation started. We’ve awarded 107 scholarships to date. Forty-three of our “Bentley Wings” scholars have graduated! Scholarships are available to Bentley Village employees or their dependents and may be used for any accredited institution offering advanced education or vocational training.

Highlighting **Ludmie Caesar** 2024 Scholarship Awardee

Ludmie Caesar, the daughter of Betty Bernard, a part-time nurse at Bentley, is the oldest of three children. She immigrated with her parents from Haiti to the US. Her family sought safety and opportunities, particularly the chance for their children to receive a quality education. Ludmie is deeply passionate about nursing, mathematics, and chemistry and is working tirelessly toward earning a Doctorate as a Certified Nurse Anesthetist.

Ludmie could only attend school two to three times a week in Haiti due to limited transportation and resources. Despite these challenges, she always prioritized education. Adjusting to life in America came with its own difficulties, but Ludmie firmly believes that with a willing heart, a sharp mind, divine blessings, and the right resources, she can achieve what she once felt was impossible.

After being turned down for several scholarships, Ludmie began to lose hope. Then came the life-changing news: she was awarded a “Bentley Wings” Competitive Scholarship. Reflecting on this moment, Ludmie shared, “I can’t put into words the happiness and gratitude I feel. Knowing the struggles that have shaped me, I deeply appreciate the person I’m becoming—thanks to your incredible generosity.”
